


PLAYING WITH TEXT BOXES

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


Select the text Button.

Select the Basic Button Font.




Type in A and B




Uncombine -

Select Edit Outline




Right click on the circle and select Create Line from Area.

Generate. You have 2 circles now, a satin circle and a running line circle.



Select the Run Circle and hit your spacebar, change the run to Motif Border.

Select a Border from the Motif menu.




Click Apply and OK

Uncombine the Satin Line from the Motif Line.

Select the Satin Circle and use the resize button  to change the circle to make it larger to fit around the Motif Circle.

You might want to change the Satin Circle to a Satin Border (Create Line from Area) and change the width to 2mm.

Place the circles 1 inside the other.



Don't forget to **SAVE** as you go.

Use the same technique for the Oval. use these for initials on Hankies or as Labels for Quilts.

You can use 2 different Motifs for a different effect. Use a feathered Satin Area.
