



DIVIDE A LINE OR SATIN OUTLINE

Make a random shape using the Freehand Line tool.




Select (blue running line).

F6 – Right Click and select Divide with Line. Cut the line in various places.




Enter – Esc – Generate

On the stitch sequence menu you will see all the parts you just cut.



You can change the sections into a motif outline if you want. If you select all the sections (Control+A) after changing to a motif outline and then

Ungroup them.  Each section can be altered in size and moved.




Remember if you alter any section you must Generate to make the changes.

Make a circle with the Create Circle Tool.



Create Outline from Area Edges.




It doesn't matter what width you use for

this exercise. I used 1.5 Satin Border.

Change the colour of the outline.

You should have 2 design parts showing on the Stitch Sequence menu.

F6 – Right Click and cut the circle like a cake.



Enter – Escape - Generate

You will bits on the Stitch sequence window that you can delete. We will add a circle to the centre. I change the colour of the cake sections and the outline sections.



Now create a circle into the centre using



the Create Circle Tool.

Select all the sections except the circle you just made.

Right Click on the grey area and select Create a Void using existing Area.

Move the cursor into the centre till you see a pink circle. Left Click and Generate.

We have got rid of the design under the circle to prevent double stitching on that area.



You can use a double, triple, motif outline etc and cut it the same way as the Satin Outline.

Just thought I'd add this to the other lesson.
