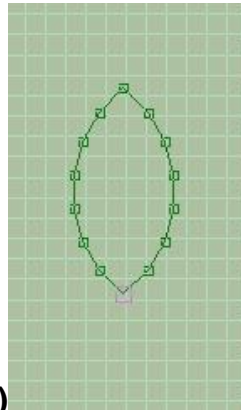
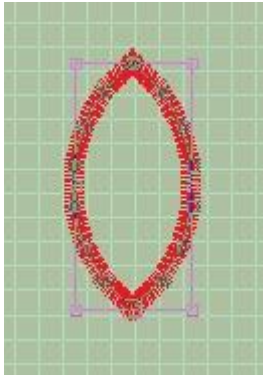


THRED – CLIPBOARD FILLS START AND FINISHING POINTS.

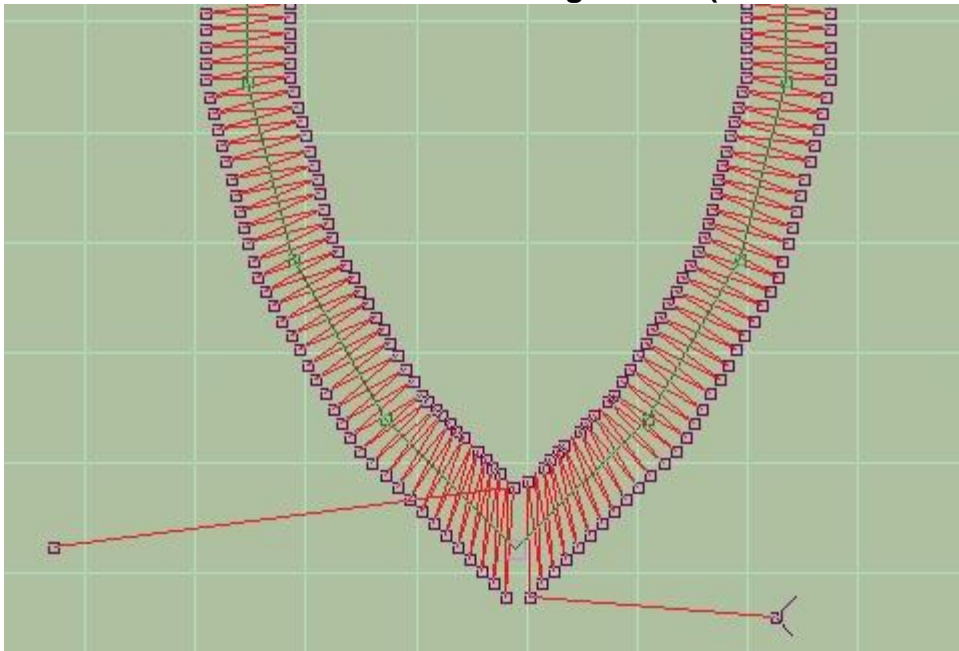
1. Open Thred.



2. Click –Form-Lens- (type in 12)

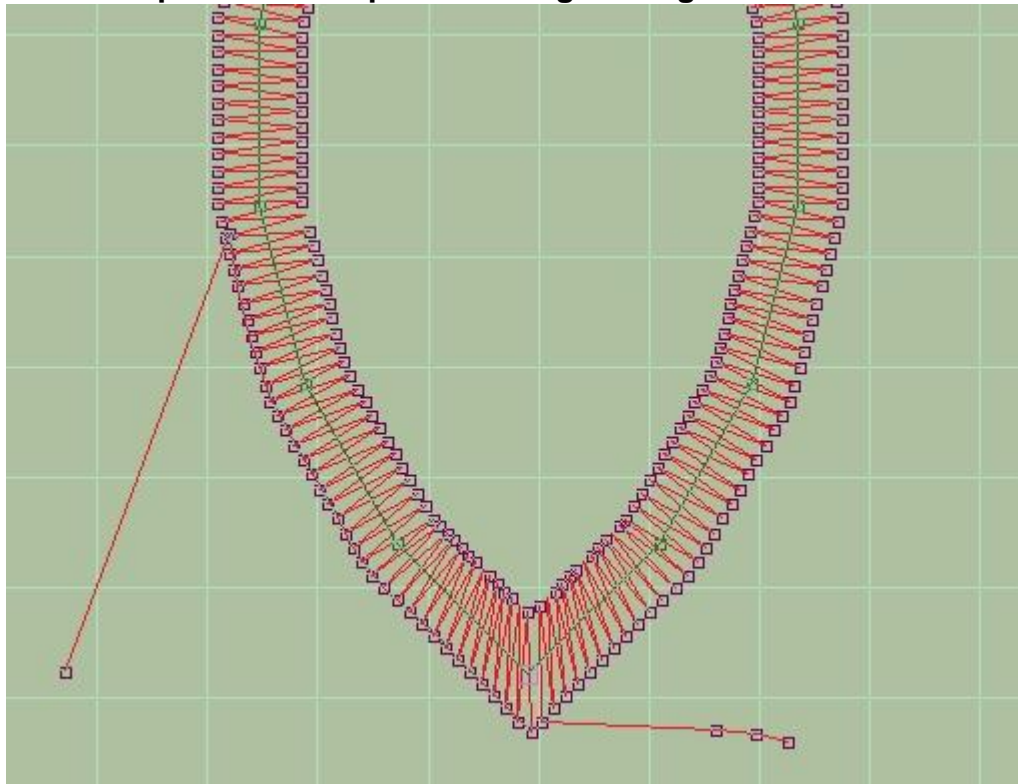


3. Click Fill-Border-Angle Satin (Satin width 1.5mm)



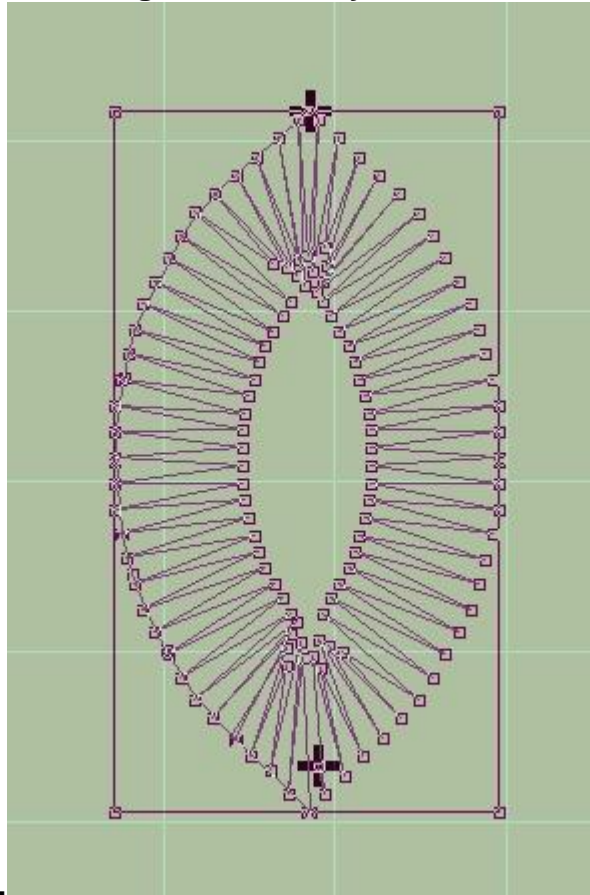
4. If you zoom in you will notice that the start and finish points are at the bottom of the design. (I have pulled them out to show you where they are). If we are going to use this as a clipboard fill we need to have

the finish point at the top of the design. design.



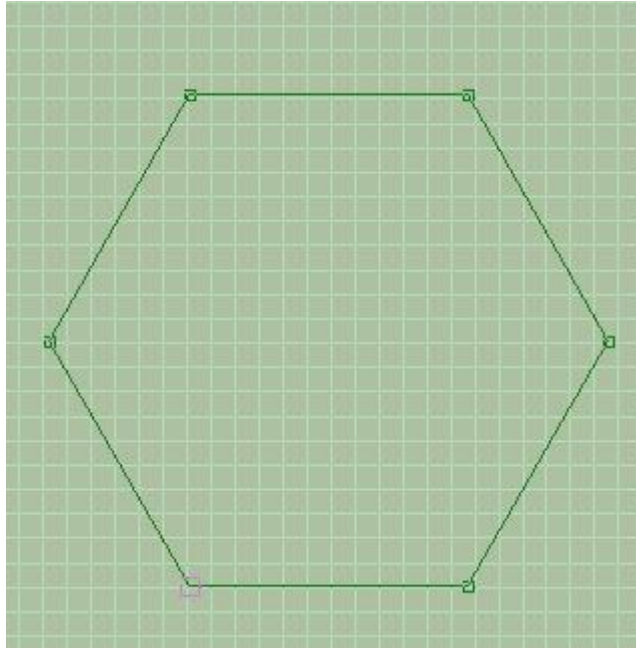
5. Add 2 stitches after the start stitch. Move these to form a zigzag stitch with the start stitch at the bottom.
6. Now we are going to add stitches to the finish so they run up the side of the design. You can press the space bar once and then add stitches with the left mouse button. Follow the line of stitches

around the side adding a stitch every 3rd stitch. Zoom in to make it



easier to see.

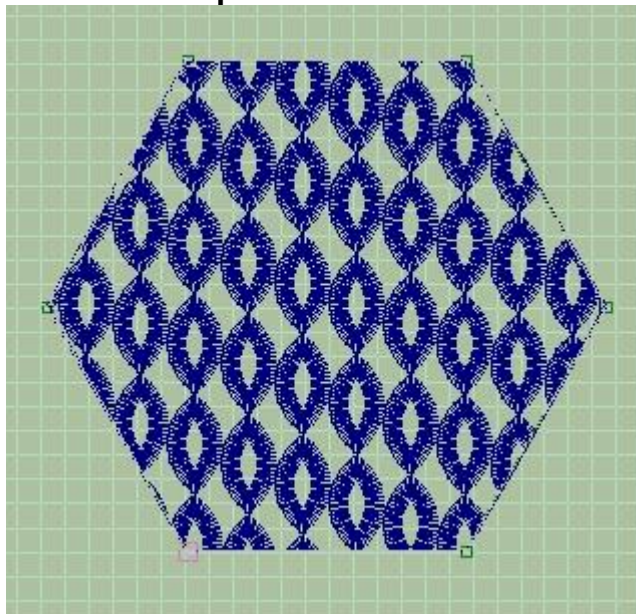
7. Now you can see where the start and finish stitches are. Reduce the design down to a small size for clipboard use. Don't forget to save this design if you want to use it again. Make sure you save it as a PCS design. (It will automatically save the Thr format for you.)
8. Make sure you have the Form selected and do a Control C to send the design to the clipboard. You can now click –Edit-Delete-Select and get rid of the clipboard design.
9. Click Form – Regular Polygon – 6 sides. Enlarge it so you can fill it better.



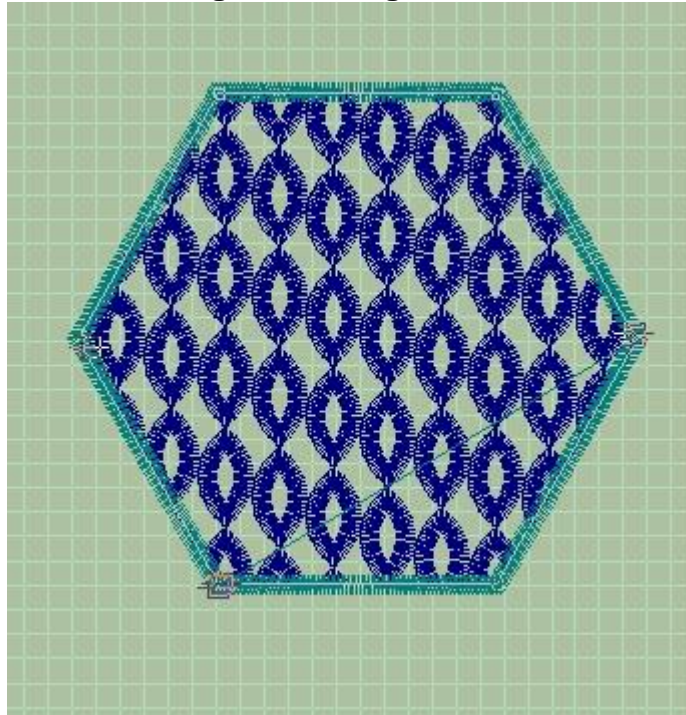
10.

With the Form still selected

Click – Fill-Clipboard- vertical.

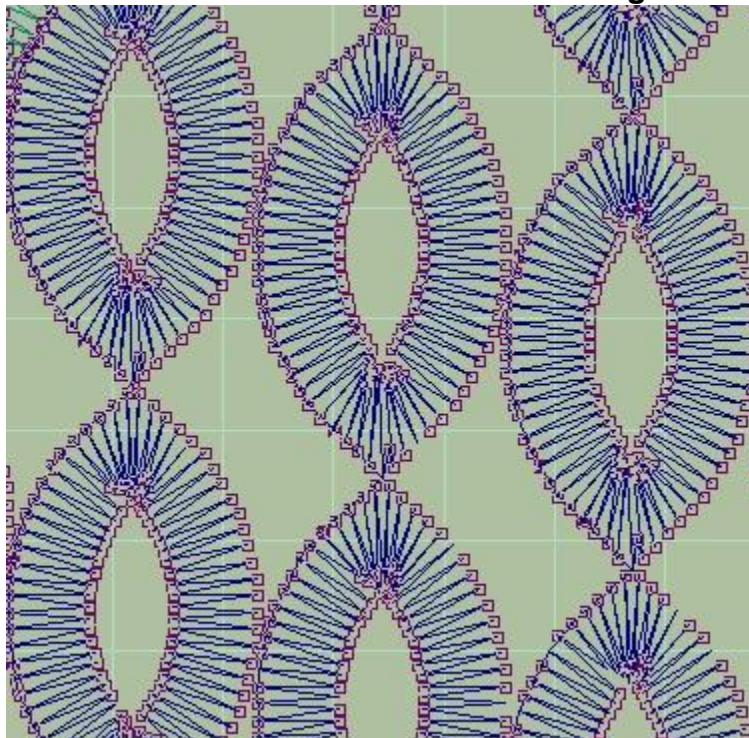


11. Now Click – Fill – Border – Angle Satin. Again choose the width of



the border satin.

12. Now Click- Edit-Set-Knots. And don't forget to Save your design.



13. With a closer look you can see the way the design looks and how we removed the jumpstitches which would have been up the centre of each clipboard fill.

You can use a variety of Clipboard fills. Play around using the heart, circle and triangle type clipboard fills to see what you can do. Don't forget to try rotating the clips and then when you use them as fills they will give you other new fills.
