

TECHNIQUE USING ZONER DRAW 4 AND CLIPART

- **STEP 1 - If you don't have Zoner Draw 4 then download the trial version from <http://www.zoner.com>**
- **STEP 2 - Open up the program.**
- **STEP 3 - The first step is to go to View - Toolbars and make sure they are all checked. (We don't want anything hidden when you first start to get to know the program.**
- **STEP 4 - Go to Galleries - check the Pen and Clipart.**
- **STEP 5 - In the clipart menu you will see a Folder icon - Browse for your clipart folder. (When I downloaded the clipart from Zoner I put mine into a folder I called 'Zoner Clipart'.) Open this folder and you will see the clipart shown as icons.**
- **STEP 6 - Double Click on the Sun Icon near the bottom of the icon list. It will appear on your work space. You can zoom in by clicking on the magnifying glass on the left hand main toolbar or click on the Square/Circle (Zoom to Object) below the magnifying glasses.**
- **STEP 7 - Look at the Pen List on the Right. You have a box called Type: Make sure the Straight Line is showing. In the Width Box use your up/down arrows to 0.60mm. Click the Color Swatch change it to Blue. The Lines either side the little green direction arrows should be straight lines.**
- **STEP 8 - Select the Sun so that the selection boxes are around it.**
- **STEP 9 - Click on the Green Tick in the Pen Tool Box. You should see a blue box appear around your Sun. You can play with altering the line thickness. i.e. 0.60mm to 0.70mm.**
- **STEP 10 - Now change the Pen to Fill. Click on the Paint Can next to the Pen.**
- **STEP 11 - Make sure the Type drop-down menu: is Solid. The Paint color is White. You should still have your Sun selected. Now click the Green Tick again. The Sun is now White with a Blue outline.**
- **You can save it in Zoner. Or you can Export it to use in your Embroidery Program. Make sure you export as a Bitmap.**
- **STEP 12 - To Export - Click File - Export - Name your file - select Windows BMP - You will get another window - Select - Dimensions - User Defined - Keep proportions - Colors 24 - No compression - Use Antialiasing - Use background Click OK.**

You can open the design in PE Design if you use that to digitize with. You may have a couple of things to clean-up but generally it is great.
